



BLOOD ROOT

Botanical Name: *Sanguinaria canadensis*

Common Name: Bloodwort, redroot, red puccoon, pauson, tetterwort

Medicinal part: Root

Description: Bloodroot is a popular natural red dye used by Native American artists, historically it was often used in tinctures and extracts to treat a variety of ailments. Bloodroot has one large basal leaf, up to 12 cm across, with 5-9 lobes. The leaves and flowers sprout from a reddish rhizome with bright orange sap that grows at or slightly below the soil surface.
