

GOLDEN SEAL HERB

Botanical Name: Hydrastis canadensis

Common Name: Orangeroot, yellow puccoon

Medicinal part: Herb (cut & sifted) or Root

Description: Goldenseal (Hydrastis canadensis), is a perennial herb in the buttercup family Ranunculaceae, native to southeastern Canada and the eastern United States. It may be distinguished by its thick, yellow knotted rootstock. The stem is purplish and hairy above ground and yellow below ground where it connects to the yellow rhizome.
