



JUNIPER BERRIES WHOLE

Botanical Name: *Juniperus communis*

Common Name: Genévrier. Ginepro. Enebro. Gemeiner Wachholder

Medicinal part: Berry

Description: A juniper berry is the female seed cone produced by the various species of junipers. It is not a true berry but a cone with unusually fleshy and merged scales, which give it a berry-like appearance. The cones from a handful of species, especially *Juniperus communis*, are used as a spice, particularly in European cuisine, and also give gin its distinctive flavour. Juniper berries have been called the only spice derived from conifers, although tar and inner bark from pine trees is sometimes considered a spice as well.
