

BAYBERRY BARK

Botanical Name: Myrica cerifera

Common Name: Wax myrtle, candleberry, myrica

Medicinal part: Root, bark, wax

Description: The bayberry plant has many uses, most notably is the use of it's cooked berries to produce winter bayberry candles—hence the nickname "candleberry". The bark is typically used in tinctures and poultices and in some countries it is burned with other barks as an insect repellant.
